To understand media imperialism, let's first define imperialism.







#### Imperialism is facilitated and resisted through media

"Firstly, processes of imperialism are in various senses executed, promoted, transformed or undermined and resisted by and through media. Secondly, the media themselves, the meanings they produce and distribute and the political-economic processes that sustain them are sculpted by and through ongoing processes of empire building and maintenance, and they carry the residues of empires that once were. Thirdly, there are media behaviors that in and of themselves and without reference to broader or more encompassing frameworks may be considered imperialistic."






# TECHNOLOGICAL IMPERIALISM

#### The Telegraph and the Ottoman Empire

"By the 1880s, approximately 20,000 miles of telegraph wires and cables stretched across the Ottoman Empire, circulating more than three million electrical messages each year"



### EARLY MEDIA IMPERIALISM



#### **Newspapers and the Occupation of Palestine**

Before the end of the First World War, Britain and France divided the territories of the defeated Ottoman empire under the Sykes-Picot Agreement of 1916.

The agreement was kept secret from the Palestinians, in part because no newspapers were permitted to be published during the war (Omer, 2015). "

### EARLY MEDIA IMPERIALISM



The 1906 Radiotelegraph Convention gathered 30 maritime States

Germany, the United States of America, Argentina (Republic of), Austria, Hungary, Belgium, the United States of Brazil, Bulgaria, Chile, Denmark, Egypt, Spain, France, Great Britain, Greece, Italy, Japan, Mexico, Monaco, Montenegro, Norway, the Netherlands, Persia, Portugal, Romania, Russia, Siam, Sweden, Turkey, and Uruguay.

#### **Carving-up Radio Spectrum**

Radio broadcasting relies on spectrum, or what Smythe (1981) calls "a peculiar natural resource" that is "nondepletable and self-renewing" yet requires global cooperation "for the radio spectrum to be used by everyone" (p. 301).

These characteristics of the radio spectrum for political economists like Smythe (1981) make radio spectrum allocation one of the best examples of the relationship between politics and technology (p. 308).

# RADIO AND COLONIALISM

The main transmitter site for the Palestine Broadcasting Service, airing the BBC's Empire Service, operated in Ramallah from March 1936 until the war of ethnic cleansing lead by Zionist militias in 1948.





# RESISTING COLONIALISM THROUGH RADIO

Fanon (1959) wrote that the Voice of Algeria broadcasts by the FLN resistance to the French occupation helped strip the "occupier's voice ... of its authority."

### NWICO

Discussions at UNESCO for a **New World Information and Communication Order (NWICO)** drew on critiques of media imperialism and became an important focus of research and advocacy during the 1970s-1980s, which saw the rise of the Right to Communicate ("Many Voices, One World," 1980).






# ENGINEERING PUBLIC CONSENT

Lies about Iraqi soldiers dumping babies out of incubators were used to secure support for the Gulf War in 1991, followed by lies about Weapons of Mass Destruction used to justify the war and occupation of Iraq in 2003.



#### MEDIA BIAS IN US NEWSPAPERS



In a recent report by <u>416Labs</u>, thousands of headlines from US newspapers were analyzed over 50 years from 1967 to 2017:

- Over four times more Israeli centric headlines than Palestinian ones.
- Israeli headlines were statistically **more significantly positive** than Palestinian ones by for all publications, except for the Washington Post.
- Over the 50-year time period, there has been a near 85% decline in the instances of the word "occupation"
- Mention of "Palestinian Refugee(s)" has declined by 93% over the 50-year period.


